In addition to partnering with HiCentral MLS, Sandicor has setup SmartLinks with MRMLS (the Multi-Regional Multiple Listing Service, Inc. serving the Riverside area), SOCAL (the Southern California Multiple Listing Service, serving the Orange County area), and CLAW (the Combined LA Westside Multiple Listing Service, serving Beverly Hills, Malibu, and Southwest Los Angeles).

Sandicor members can begin exploring these systems in TEMPO via the MySideBar, SmartLinks section. SmartLink allows Sandicor members guest permission based access into other MLS software systems where they can search for properties, view detailed property information, print property reports, and even email out property information to yourself and forward it to your clients. In addition, the Sandicor member has access to search and view detailed agent, broker, and real estate office information.
